At the Movies: Zootopia

ISAIAH 11:6-8 (NLT) | WEEK 4

Opening Questions

- 1. Talk about the movie *Zootopia* as a group. Describe scenes that were important or memorable to you.
- 2. As an adult, what are some innocent childhood ideals like those Judy had in the movie that have faded for you over the years? How do you view those ideals today?
- 3. What questions would you like to ask Pastor Carter about his message?

In the Word

- 1. Read Isaiah 11:6-8 (NLT), Ephesians 6:12, Galatians 1:4, and 1 Corinthians 12:7, 12-14.
- 2. As a group, talk about the picture Isaiah paints in chapter 11. What qualities that stand out to you?
- 3. How does Ephesians 6:12 describe evil in the world today? What are some recent examples?
- 4. In Galatians 1, what difference does Jesus specifically make? What other verses describe the impact of His sacrifice? What more can we learn about Jesus' sacrifice?
- 5. In 1 Corinthians 12, how does Paul's description of the church help people see Jesus' sacrifice? How should the church stand out in contrast to the world?
- 6. Read Revelation 21:1-5. What aspect of heaven seems most appealing to you and why?

Making It Personal

- 1. What are some specific struggles in the world that impact you? What examples of predator vs prey do you regularly see and grieve over? How do these seem truly evil?
- 2. Describe how Jesus' sacrifice has impacted and transformed your life. Be specific. What are the biggest growth areas remaining for you?
- 3. Brainstorm an individual or family in your Home Team, or outside your group, that is suffering in some specific and difficult way. How could your group reach out and help? Make a simple plan.
- 4. Pray together for God to bring more of heaven to earth through you individually and as a group.
