- 1. Read 1 Corinthians chapter 12.
- 2. How does chapter 12 reinforce/expound on Todd's three main points.
 - A. Every follower of Jesus has the full gift of God's Spirit.
 - B. Every follower of Jesus has a unique spiritual gift.
 - C. Every follower of Jesus is to use their spiritual gift for the common good.
- 3. In 1 Corinthians 12:12-31, what stands out to you regarding how the spiritual gifts mentioned in the first part of the chapter should function in one body?
- 4. What is unique about the body (church) compared to other organizations, clubs, or groups in the way Paul describes it in chapter 12?

5. In addition to 1 Corinthians 12:7-11, a list of spiritual gifts is given in Romans 12:6-9 and Ephesians 4:11-12. Compare those passages with 1 Corinthians. How are they similar and how are they different?

Making It Personal

- 1. If you have not been serving regularly in and through the church, what prevents you from doing so?
- 2. Review the list of spiritual gifts from question 5 above. What gift(s) has God's Spirit has equipped you?
- 3. When you consider Paul's picture of the church as a body, how would you evaluate Pathway's strengths and growth areas? What about the strengths and growth areas of your Home Team?
- 4. Talk about specific next steps you can take individually and as a Home Team to serve Christ using God-given gifts through Pathway Church.
