Opening Questions

- 1. What kinds of sin or temptation do you think most Americans are likely to give in to and why?
- 2. Describe consequences not usually considered regarding temptation and sin.

In the Word

- 1. Read James 1:1-18 (message focused on verses 13-15).
- Pastor Carter talked about the source of temptation, consequences, and viewing ourselves as God views us. What do verses 13-18 specifically say about these subjects?
- 3. Summarize one important point from verses 13-18 in your own words.
- 4. Pastor Carter also talked about the steps of desire, deception, design, disobedience, and death. How are these reflected in James and which ones do we tend to overlook?
- 5. How do verses 16-18 contrast to verses 13-15? What do verses 16-18 tell us about God's hope and vision for His people who want to follow Jesus?

Making It Personal

- 1. What temptation toward sin are you facing that you need to take seriously and resist?
- 2. What steps should you take this week to avoid sin and temptation? How can you gain accountability?
- 3. Break into smaller groups (pairs or separate men/women) and spend some time in confession and prayer with each other.
- 4. Send a text, email, or written note to someone close to you who is struggling to encourage them and offer your help.

Continued Learning

1. Look at Jesus' temptation in the wilderness in Luke 4:1-13. What can we learn about sin, temptation, and resisting from these verses?
