Opening Questions

1. Describe confusion you think people may have today regarding the Holy Spirit.
2. Describe a time when you felt, experienced, or were led by the Holy Spirit. What happened?

In the Word

1. Read [1 Samuel 3](#), [John 14:16-17](#), [John 16:7-8](#), [John 16:13](#), and [Acts 13:1-12](#).
2. Look at each of the passages above individually and in comparison with each other. Consider these questions:
 - a. What do these passages tell us about the work of God's Holy Spirit?
 - b. How are the specific circumstances (contexts) different in each passage? What difference do you think that makes?
 - c. In John, what does Jesus specifically promise regarding Himself and the Holy Spirit?
 - d. What do these passages communicate to us about listening to the Holy Spirit? What's needed?
 - e. What do these scriptures tell us about God giving specific direction to individuals, families, or even groups?
 - f. How can the Holy Spirit work in a positive way—moving us toward God or even in a way that keeps us from evil or sin?
 - g. What other questions do these verses answer about the Holy Spirit? What questions do these verses raise?

Making It Personal

1. How open are you to the Holy Spirit's leadership and influence in your life including righteousness, convicting of sin and faith?
2. As you've read these verses this week and been open to God, what do you believe God is leading you to do or not to do? What areas is God bringing conviction into your life? Do you think God has been speaking in some way and you've not been willing to listen or hear?
3. Is there a person God may be directing you to care for or to reach out to; who is it? What steps can you take this coming week?
4. Spend time in prayer to be more open to God and His Holy Spirit.
