Opening Questions

- 1. Have you ever received news that was both exciting and scary? What was it and how did you react?
- 2. When was the last time you wanted to believe the best about a person but the circumstances looked suspicious? What did you do? What happened?

In the Word

- 1. Read Matthew 1:18-25.
- 2. In verse 19, Joseph is trying to balance keeping the Law with kindness toward Mary. What does verse 19 tell us about Joseph's character and his relationship with Mary?
- 3. Summarize the angel's message to Joseph. How many things does the angel communicate?
- 4. The name Jesus is the Greek form of the name Joshua. What similarities are there between Jesus and Joshua from the Old Testament? (Hint: look through the book of Joshua!)
- 5. Verse 23 gives the important name Immanuel (God with us). In what ways is this name uniquely appropriate for Jesus?
- 6. Verses 24-25 detail Joseph's response. How might Joseph have reacted? What is amazing about his response?

Making It Personal

- 1. If God communicated to you through an angel this Christmas about a difficult decision or circumstance, what message would God deliver to you?
- 2. Who in your life is struggling this Christmas that God wants you to encourage and walk beside?
- 3. In what specific ways does God want Jesus to be seen through your life this Christmas?
- 4. Pray for those you're inviting to church this Christmas Eve to be open to God and Jesus.
