- 4. Titus 3:1, 3:8, and 3:14 all talk about doing good to different people. Why is it so important to do good that in Titus 3:8 Paul insists on Titus doing this?
- 5. What does the close of this letter in Titus 3:12-15 tell us about Paul? Are there any implications for us from these verses?

- 2. Give an example of habituation from your life.
- 3. Describe an area in your life that has been renewed by the power of the Holy Spirit.
