Hebrews 12:1, Hebrews 11:40, Mark 9:5, Luke 16:19-31, Luke 20:37-38

#### IN THE WORD

- 1. Hebrews 12:1 is a reference back to Hebrews 11. Who in Hebrews 11 most inspires your faith?
- 2. How does Hebrews 11:40 make you feel?
- 3. Have you ever wondered how Peter recognized Moses and Elijah in Mark 9:5? How do you think he recognized them?
- 4. What surprises you about Jesus' parable in Luke 16:19-31? What do you think the disciples took away from this parable?

#### MAKING IT PERSONAL

- How do you think Peter felt when he saw Moses and Elijah with Jesus?
- 2. What relationship do you most look forward to having renewed or reconciled?
- 3. Who do you look forward to seeing again in heaven?
- 4. In Jesus' parable about Lazarus, He says, "If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead." What does that tell you? Does it prompt you to change anything?
- 5. Pray about those you would like to see in heaven with you someday.

Read through 1 Corinthians 15:1-28 to better understand the path that has lead to heaven for each of us. What concept stands out to you?
