- 2. How does the concept of grace fit with Matthew 16:27?
- 3. Jesus gives a response to a young man in Matthew 19:21. Share what this response means for us today.
- 4. Explain the meaning of Matthew 19:29.
- 5. What does this lasting foundation consist of in 1 Corinthians 3:10-15?

#### MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Why do you think Jesus and Paul talk about rewards in heaven? Motivation to serve, inspiration in difficulty, to encourage us in loss, or another reason?
- 2. This idea of sacrificing now so that we receive a reward in heaven seems almost self-serving. Explain how it is not.
- 3. What have you given up in your life for the Kingdom's sake?
- 4. How does this idea of reward in heaven help you?
