- 1. How can you identify with Paul's struggles to obey God in Romans 7:21-25?
- 2. In what way does Romans 8:1 help us with temptation?
- 3. Romans 8:1 gives us the only solution to our struggle with sin. Share how you would explain that to a Christian struggling with an addiction or a sin in their life.
- 4. Reading through Ephesians 1:13-14, what stands out in this passage to you? What seems confusing in that passage?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. How have you seen people struggle trying to work their way to heaven?
- 2. Are there struggles in your life that cause you to doubt that you will go to heaven?
- 3. If you knew you were going to heaven, how would that affect the decisions you make this week?
- 4. With whom can you share this good news about the certainty of going to heaven with this week?
- 5. Break into prayer partners to thank God for the Holy Spirit that helps us understand heaven will one day be our home. Share and pray for each other with any struggles that make you doubt heaven as the destination of your life.
